## **Striking Competition for the Taylor Trophy**

#### Rules

### General

- 1. The competition will be held at Stoney Stanton on Saturday April 27<sup>th</sup> 2019
- 2. The draw for ringing order will take place during the preceding week.
- 3. Towers and/or districts may enter teams but it is expected that each participant will be a regular Sunday service ringer at a tower within the Guild.
- 4. Each tower or district may enter more than one team but no member may ring more than once.
- 5. The competition will be restricted to 8 teams.
- 6. Application should be made on the form below enclosing £4.00 entrance fee. (Cheques to "Leicester Diocesan Guild" please)
- 7. The winning team will be presented with The Taylor Trophy to retain until the next competition.

#### **Test Piece.**

- 8. The test piece will be 120 call changes on six bells and must include Queens and Titums.
- 9. Each team will be allowed 15 minutes to enter the tower, practice, ring the test piece and leave the tower. An additional person may be used if required to count the number of rows. This person may not perform any other role whilst the test piece is rung.
- 10. The test piece will be preceded with one whole pull of the treble to alert the judges.

#### Judging.

- 11. The judge(s) will be selected at the invitation of the organisers.
- 12. Only 120 changes will be judged.
- 13. All interpretations and matters not covered by these rules will be decided by the organisers, whose decision will be final.
